Select "Create New Team." On the next page, enter your students' first and last name, as well as what division they will be competing in (Middle School or High School). Teams must contain at least 3 students, but no more than 4 students.

Step 2) Getting Student Access Codes

For students to participate, they must use an access code you provide them with. You can find these access codes by either a) downloading a CSV file of all students you have registered, or b) viewing the codes for just one team on the website.
